Placing the "promotion of environmentally and socially conscious, sustainable corporate activities" as a top priority for our business management (materiality), we are accelerating our initiative to reduce CO_2 emissions in line with the carbon-neutral concept. To this end, we are combining different options including fuel conversion to low-carbon energy sources, streamlining of the production process, introduction of state-of-the-art manufacturing equipment, and shift to environmentally-friendly production items.

As part of the initiative, we have established the Sustainability Promotion Committee to promote our approach to the issues of environmental, social, and corporate governance (ESG)/sustainable development goals (SDGs), sustainability, and response to climate change, and organized a promotion system with clear management roles.

The TAYCA Group will continue its efforts to contribute to achieving a sustainable society by promoting disclosure of information related to the response to climate change in alignment with the recommendations of the TCFD and accelerating measures to realize carbon neutrality.
